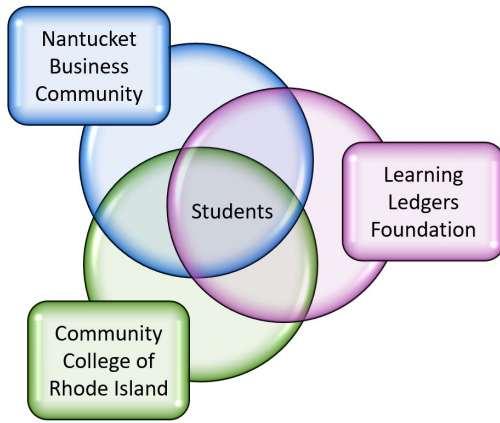

## How It Works

- ◆ Students take classes online at the Community College of Rhode Island.
- ◆ Students attend supplemental in-person seminars on Nantucket to deepen their remote learning experiences.
- ◆ Jobs and internships offer critical real-life work experiences and an income.
- ◆ Students receive CCRI credit for their jobs and internships if they participate in discussion roundtables, complete reflection assignments, and a final paper.
- ◆ The roundtables connect skills learned on the job with material learned in class.
- ◆ Mentorship programs provide support and develop social capital and talent.
